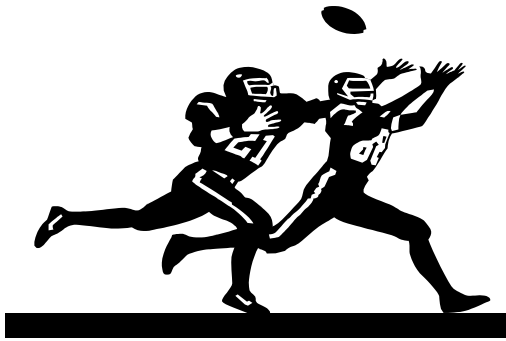


SESSION TIMES AND AGES
